



## Letchworth DTC Rally Obedience Points League 2011

1. Points can only be claimed from the date of membership.
2. Points are in relation to the dog, not who handles it.
3. You must train the dog for which you are claiming points at least 20 weeks per year at the club to be entitled to awards. Dogs that attend fewer lessons than this may still claim points, *entries not entitled to silverware will be in italics*.
4. A minimum total of **five** dogs must claim points for this trophy to be awarded.
5. You can claim “Official” points for any formal Rally Obedience competition – these are Talking Dogs (known as “Talking Dogs Rally”), Janet West (“Pet Dog Rally Obedience”), A.P.D.T. (“UK Rally”).  
“Unofficial” points may be claimed for any other informal Rally Obedience competition **provided it is open to all Letchworth DTC members** (e.g. at Companion dog shows). The points gained from these competitions shall be worth half the points of official shows.
6. It does not matter at which level or in which stream the dog competes. The dog is deemed to be competing at ‘its level’.
7. Only qualifying scores of 170 points or more may be entered.  
Points cannot be claimed for the following:
  - i. Any show that is not available to all Letchworth DTC members.
  - ii. Rally courses held at Letchworth DTC during classes
8. The winner is the dog with the highest total of points.
